### who is eligible?

In order to participate, students need to attend high school, trade school or be a college student in one of the following counties: Crawford, Dent, Gasconade, Maries, Phelps, Pulaski or Washington.

### rewards

**First place** winners receive: *\$50 Savings Bond*  
**Second place** winners receive: *Earth-friendly gifts (\$15 value)*

All participants will receive a small token from the district.

### deadline

Entries should be left at the county clerk's office of your local courthouse to be picked up by the district or delivered directly to MRPC, 4 Industrial Drive, St. James before March 30, 2012.

\*\*If submitting more than five trash art projects, please contact the district to arrange transport.

### contest rules

- ⇒ The district is opening a new category this year for electronic art (created on a computer). This is open to students in high school, trade school, or college students. Participants **MUST** be students. One first and second place winner will be chosen from all grades entering this category.
- ⇒ Honorable mention certificates will be awarded based on judges' discretion. All decisions of the judges are final.
- ⇒ All winners and honorable mentions will receive a certificate from the district in recognition of their achievement.
- ⇒ Posters submitted to the contest will become the property of the district.
- ⇒ Winning posters, if reproducible, may be used in the district's public awareness and information campaigns, T-shirt designs, etc.
- ⇒ On the back of each poster entry, the student **must** include the following information:
  - Student Name and Home Address
  - Grade and Age
  - School District
  - School Name and Teacher's Name
- ⇒ Any entry that does not have proper identification may be disqualified.
- ⇒ Posters should be no larger than 11"x17".
- ⇒ Notification of winning entries will be sent to schools early in April.
- ⇒ Awards will be distributed in late April and early May.
