
Water Heater Guidelines



- Water heaters must be positioned on a sturdy and level surface.
- Gas water heaters must be vented to the outside of the unit according to city codes.
- Electric water heaters must secure electric wire into top of water heater with a Romex Clamp.
- All fuel oil and gas water heaters need to have a safety divider/shield, if located in bedrooms or other living areas.
- The overflow pipe should extend from the pressure relief valve to no more than six inches from the floor or through the floor, at the owner's option for compliance with HUD housing standards.
- Overflow pipe must be either hard copper or plastic (PVC).
