As ORSWMD chairperson, I attend Solid Waste Advisory Board (SWAB) meetings on behalf of the district. The SWAB consists of 20 district chairpersons with two representatives of the solid waste industry; two members of the public with an interest in solid waste management issues; and a representative of the recycling or composting industry. The SWAB advises the Missouri Department of Natural Resources on:

- Solid waste management issues and challenges pertinent to the districts
- The effects of proposed rules and regulations upon solid waste management districts
- The development of improved methods of solid waste minimization, recycling and resource recovery

At the January SWAB meeting, members discussed the current challenges of Missouri's sheltered workshops and the impact of recent changes in federal regulations seeking to integrate people with disabilities into competitive jobs that pay at least the minimum wage, and how these regulations may impact Missouri's sheltered workshops.

Sheltered workshops have provided valuable recycling services throughout our district, especially in rural areas with minimal access to recycling. Since 2008, Ozark Rivers has provided \$80,000 to sheltered workshops in Dent, Phelps and Washington counties to further those efforts.

We invite you to attend a presentation by Joan Nodalski, Director of the Rolla Area Sheltered Workshop. Ms. Nodalski will share how they have met present challenges and their plans for expanding their scope of recycling services.
