- 2. Approval of October 13, 2016 TAC Minutes: John Casey, Chairman. Committee action required.
- 3. **Road Safety Audits:** As part of its work program, MRPC proposed to conduct one or two road safety audits prior to June 30. A Road Safety Audit (RSA) is a formal safety performance examination of an existing or future road or intersection by an independent audit team. The RSA team considers the safety of all road users, qualitatively estimates and reports on the road safety issues identified, and presents suggestions for safety improvements. TAC members will develop a list of potential locations that might benefit from a road safety audit.
- 4. **Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) Application Prioritization:** A representative of each application will have up to five minutes to present his/her project to the TAC. Upon completion of all presentations, TAC members will prioritize the applications, and the TAC will then vote to recommend the priorities to the MRPC board. There are six applications for review.
- 5. **Transportation Needs Prioritization:** A representative of each county will have up to five minutes to make a presentation on the top three transportation needs of his/her county. Upon completion of all county presentations, TAC members will use the dot method to prioritize the top 24 transportation needs of the region. The TAC will then vote to recommend the list to the MRPC board.
- 6. **MoDOT Updates and Staff Reports (As time allows):** Central District engineers will update TAC members on local projects. MRPC staff will report.
- 7. **Member Reports (As time allows):** Time allowed for local transportation issues to be brought to the attention of the TAC.
