MINUTES

Call to Order & Welcome: Darin Pryor, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 4:01 p.m.

Approval of June 9, 2022 TAC Minutes: Steve Vogt motioned to approve the minutes as presented; Larry Kliethermes seconded. The minutes were approved.

Nominating Committee: Members appointed to the nominating committee were: Charles Bassett (Pulaski), Vic Stratman (Maries), Joey Auxier (Phelps) and Larry Kliethermes (Osage); however, only Vic Stratman and Larry Kliethermes were in attendance at the pre-meeting prior to the evening's TAC. Since Darryl Griffin and Ron Kempker were also at MRPC, they participated in the Nominating Committee voting. The committee chose to nominate all existing officers for a second term. Current officers are: Darin Pryor (Phelps), Chairman; Steve Vogt (Maries), Vice-Chairman; and T.R. Dudley (Washington), Secretary. Joey Auxier motioned to accept and approve the nominations for Chair, Vice-Chair and Secretary; Darrell Skiles seconded. The officers were approved as nominated for a second term.

BRO Application Ranking: Anne Freand and Bonnie Prigge discussed the Bridge Replacement Off-System (BRO) process and changes to the funding program this year. Representatives from each county that applied for funding were given a chance to present their priorities. TAC members were then asked to rank the projects in priority order. The final priorities were presented to the committee for approval (see attached listing). Dale Martin motioned to approve the prioritization; Vic Stratman seconded. BRO Priorities were approved.

High Priority Unfunded Needs - Road/Bridge and Multimodal Projects Prioritization: MoDOT provided an overview of the High Priority Unfunded Needs and MRPC staff reviewed the existing needs on Tiers 1, 2, and 3. The committee then reviewed and approved the top Road/Bridge and Multimodal needs for the Meramec Region (see attached listings). Leo Sanders recommended approval of the Road/Bridge list as prioritized; Jared Boast seconded. The Road/Bridge priorities were approved. Joey Auxier recommended approval of the Multimodal list as prioritized; Vic Stratman seconded. The Multimodal priorities were approved.

TAP Application Review: Kim Tipton, MoDOT, provided an update on the applications received in the Meramec Region. She noted that for the first time there was more money available than applications and even recent applications from last year were funded. Kim noted that an upcoming grant round would happen for the remaining money (approx. \$422,000) but was not sure of the exact timing. She encouraged cities and counties to apply since additional money would be available next year.

Transit and Active Transportation Planning: Anne Freand, MRPC, provided an update on the transit and active transportation planning activities in the region, including the work in Salem and potential upcoming work along the Rock Island Trail in Rosebud, Belle and Bland. Bonnie Prigge noted that the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) and the Missouri Rock Island Trail (MoRIT) have partnered with the National Park Service on planning efforts with the community.

Road Safety Audit (RSA) Update: Anne Freand reviewed information regarding the Road Safety Audit for the intersection of S Hwy 21 and Delbridge Road in Washington County. The virtual RSA included many comments from stakeholders and residents of the area. Improvements include tree trimming, squaring up the intersection, repairs to pavement and striping to improve entrance and exits from the non-traditional intersection.

Show Me Zero Fatality Update: Bonnie Prigge provided a handout to committee members. She also noted Back to School fair activities, and that staff would be attending the Highway Safety Conference the last week in September. MRPC still has signs in the front lobby if anyone would like them for their business or location.

MoDOT Updates and Staff Reports (As time allows): Kim Tipton noted that TEAP applications are due on Sept. 23, 2022. ADA Transition plans or assistance with TAP applications are possible projects. Kim also noted that agreements for TAP and BRO will come through via Docusign as more items are going digital.

Member Reports (As time allows): No additional reports were given.
